Group agreed that they need to be more aware of the units they are representing and make sure information is shared. Reminded members where meeting minutes are located. Committee could identify key topics that library staff could prepare for a short series of presentations. Culshaw is always willing to meet with campus groups.
- 3. Updates from the University Librarian
 - a. Spring semester is busy. For Main Library, busiest days of the weeks are Mon-Thursday. Last fall our peak was November 7th when there were 1,831 people in the building.
 - b. Key priorities for 2023 include recruiting a new AUL; reviewing and refining our organizational structure; and assessing our teams.
 - c. Budget is on track for FY23; no cancellation projects are likely needed through FY24.
 - d. Continue to make case for next phase of Main Library renovation. Have created a task force to get student feedback to tell the story in a new way.
 - e. Hardin Library is currently under renovation including new restrooms and offices. Within two years most of Hardin will have been renovated.
 - f. Current gallery exhibit is Queer Life in Iowa City.

1. Welcome and introductions.

- 2. The revised committee charge has been approved by campus governance groups and is now ready to go to the Provost.
- 3. Walton gave an update on the FY23 materials budget which was reduced by about \$750,000 in last year's cancellation project. Some vendor negotiations are ongoing. Walton noted that open access initiatives through BTAA are important as group purchases makes things affordable, especially since over 90% of our purchases are subscription based.
- 4. Updates from University Librarian.
 - a. Gatecounts are up this fall when compared to last year. During the week, we are up 20% over last fall and 54% increase on the weekends.
 - b. Since Jan 1 year we have had 14 library staff departures, 8 were retirements. Have made 11 new hires and 5 active searches.
 - c. Announced that Walton is stepping down as AUL and becoming the director of the RML as of January 1. The Libraries will recruit for a new AUL with an interim plan in place soon.
 - d. We are the bottom of our peer group in number of staff. Using funds from the strategic materials reduction, the Libraries implemented a staff retention program which included a market salary analysis for all of our P&S staff. We were able to move salaries up for about 80% of our staff as well as increase the starting salary ranges for librarian classifications. The other staff investment initiative is to hire up to 20 new FTE positions. Some of those recruitments are underway now.
 - e. The planning for Main Library renovation is on-going with a financial model being developed. Hardin Library first floor is being renovated to accommodate additional UI offices. A plan to renovate the second and third floors are on hold. However, the fourth floor will be under construction next spring because of a \$850K Carver Charitable Trust grant that will allow us to convert stacks to student study spaces.
- 5. Brainstormed topics for future meetings: special collections and collaborations with departments/students; partnering with Stanley and the SpecColl/Stanley shared position; exhibit gallery; Digital Studio; updates from library units.
