The University of Iowa Libraries is a depository for US federal, State of Iowa, United Nations, and European Union publications. Through depository programs, publications are received from these agencies with the understanding that they will be freely and readily available to the public. In addition, the government publications collection incorporates many other official government resources and complementary materials that enhance research activities. Primary resources include official reports, statistical publications, legislative information with supporting secondary material such as periodicals, policy analysis publications, and general information guides. Recent titles can be found through the [InfoHawk Catalog](#) and other [databases](#) provide indexing or full-text of many public policy documents. Most print government resources are available in the government information collection on the third floor of the Main Library. However, other libraries on campus may also have government resources in their collections. Microfiche and CD-ROMs and DVDs are located in the Main Library Reference Collection on the first floor.

The government information collection includes over 3 million volumes in formats ranging from paper and microform, to electronic resources including CD-ROM, DVD, and Internet-based resources. A growing number of government titles are available in full-text through links in the [InfoHawk Catalog](#). However, be aware that many historical materials are not represented at all through the InfoHawk Catalog. They are, however, indexed through specialized print indexes. Please [ask a librarian](#) for help finding older materials.
