from the CURATOR

I love sports. And so does the University of Iowa.

I grew up in Iowa and have been faculty in (what is now) the Sport Media and Culture program at the University of Iowa for nearly a decade. I research and teach about sports—about their histories, current events, their cultural importance, their intersections with race and gender, their relationships with the media, politics, and the economy, their role locally and globally, and their power and potential. Researching and curating sport-focused exhibits is also something I cherish—as pedagogy and scholarship. These interests of mine have merged in *Hawkeye Histories* | *Sporting Stories* in an effort to engage the superfan, the casual passerby, and visitors to the exhibit that fall somewhere inbetween.

Sports have long played an important role at the University of Iowa. But the role sports have played—at Iowa, at universities, in the United States—has changed over time.

With nearly 150 years of athletes, teams, and coaches, there are too many Hawkeye histories to tell in one exhibit. And yet, I couldn't resist trying when the opportunity arose. While I've been researching and teaching the history of sports at Iowa since I arrived on campus, curating this exhibit has at least doubled my (still admittedly partial) knowledge. Selecting the items you'll see on display was both agonizing and gloriously fun. To use a sporting metaphor, I was swimming in potential sporting stories. Our archival collections are awash with incredible sporting items and artifacts. The exhibit Hawkeye Histories | Sporting Stories is a carefully curated and narrated selection of the University of Iowa's countless sporting pasts.

The exhibit is meant to be representative rather than comprehensive—to allocate balanced space to a breadth of sporting stories, rather than focusing attention on just a few.

The exhibit is meant to be contextual rather than myopic—to situate Iowa's sports histories in relation to each other



and broader issues, movements, and policies rather than narrating stand-alone stories.

I've come to think about the exhibit as more of a beginning than an end, and I am eager to continue to explore the histories of sport at the University of Iowa in their many forms and formulations. If you see me around, please ask me about the exhibit—but also ask me about the items that aren't on display or what stories I'd like to tell next. And tell me your stories.

Finally, this exhibit would not have been possible without the collaborative learning opportunities I have had with my students, the University Libraries resources and relationships I've depended on, and my supportive colleagues in the Department of American Studies and School of Journalism and Mass Communication. I am profoundly grateful.




