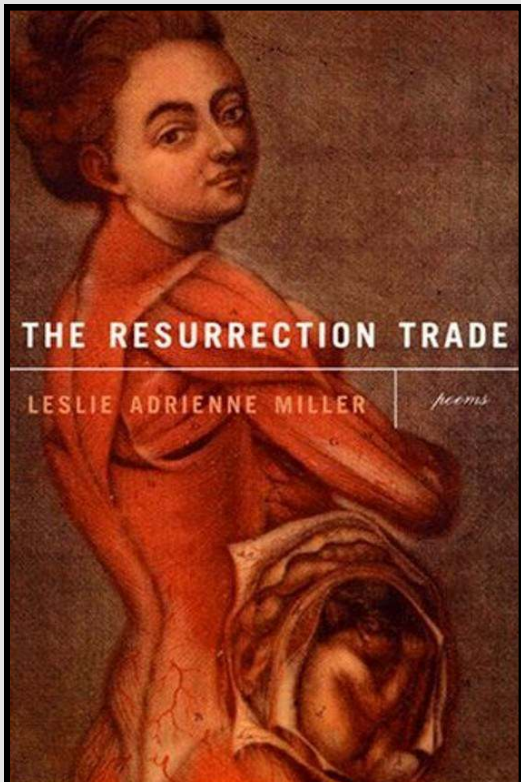

“The resurrection trade,” the business of trafficking in corpses, is an old trade, one that makes possible the art of anatomy and the art



of her own book. Miller delves into the mysteries of early anatomical studies and medical illustrations

and finds there stories of women’s lives—sometimes tragic, sometimes comic—as exposed as the drawings themselves. The poems become powerful testimonies to women’s bodies objectified and misunderstood throughout history and bring a new truth to what she calls “the strange collusion of imaginary science and real art.”
